

Re: Medical coverage policy update - Frequency limitation for respiratory pathogen panel testing effective November 12, 2023

We routinely review our coverage, reimbursement, and administrative policies for potential updates. In that review, we take into consideration one or more of the following: Evidence-based medicine (EBM), professional society recommendations, Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) guidance, industry standards, and our other existing policies.

As a result of a recent review, we will deny respiratory pathogen panel testing as not medically necessary when administered at a frequency greater than either 12 in a 12-month rolling timeframe or one per day. Denials will affect the claim line only and include medical necessity appeal rights.

This update is effective for dates of service on or after November 12, 2023. We will update the Nucleic Acid Pathogen Testing (0530) medical coverage policy to reflect this change.

## At a glance

- We will deny respiratory pathogen panel testing as not medically necessary when administered at a frequency greater than either 12 in a 12-month rolling timeframe or one per day.
